Gynaecological cancer symptoms and action

The symptoms of gynaecological cancer can be varied and may include:

- abnormal or persistent vaginal bleeding for example, bleeding after menopause, bleeding that is not part of menstrual periods, or bleeding after sex unusual vaginal discharge
- pain, pressure or discomfort in the abdomen
- changes in bowel or bladder habits
- pain during sex
- itching, burning or soreness lumps, sores or wart-like growths.

If any of these symptoms are new for you it's important that they are discussed with your doctor.
