
VULVAR CANCER SYMPTOMS

Below are some of the key symptoms to look out for that might indicate vulvar cancer. It's critical that women consult a doctor if they experience these symptoms for a period of more than three weeks.

A lump somewhere on the vulvar, commonly on the inner edges of the labia majora or labia minora

Growths on the vulva that look like warts or ulcers





Vaginal bleeding that is not menstruation

Tenderness of the vulvar area



Colour changes in the skin of the vulva
