
VULVAR CANCER SYMPTOMS

Below are some of the key symptoms to look out for that might indicate vulvar cancer. It's critical that women consult a doctor if they experience these symptoms for a period of more than three weeks.

A lump somewhere on the vulva, commonly on the inner edges of the labia majora or labia minora



Growths on the vulvar that look like warts or ulcers





Vaginal bleeding that is not menstruation







Colour changes in the skin of the vulvar
