UTERINE CANCER SYMPTOMS

Below are some of the key symptoms to look out for that might indicate uterine cancer. It's critical that women consult a doctor if they experience these symptoms for a period of more than three weeks

The most common symptom is abnormal vaginal bleeding, especially after menopause. This may include spotting, bleeding between periods, or heavier-usual-periods.



Unusual vaginal discharge that may be watery, pink or brown



Difficulty urinating, pain when urinating or frequent urination



Pain during intercourse



Pelvic pain or a feeling of pressure in the lower abdomen
